Common issues you may experience with your turbocharger include:

- ✓ Running in limp mode (restricted performance)

Turbochargers have become increasingly popular over the years as you generally get more power output from the same size engine.

Turbochargers also burn fuel with more oxygen, they tend to burn it more thoroughly and cleanly, producing less air pollution.

Most common turbocharger faults are caused by a lack of lubrication, poor quality oil or a cold engine. Regular quality oil changes and allowing the vehicle's engine to warm up before driving will all help to extend the life of a turbocharger.

Turbochargers are most commonly found in diesel engines with 'Diesel Particulate Filters' (DPFs) often suffering problems related to the turbocharger failing. However an increasing amount of petrol-fuelled engines are now also being built with turbochargers.

It is advised that you replace the oil in your engine at every service interval in order to make sure that your diesel turbo doesn't fail.
